



What does a typical day look like in a first-year WRI class?

There is a lot of variety across first-year WRI classes, but WRI classes highly value classroom community, collaboration, and the practice of writing. So, a typical day might include:

1. Discussion: small-or-large-group discussions about readings or other course topics;
2. Collaboration: working with peers to develop projects, review drafts, or analyze readings.
3. Writing: freewriting about a topic, brainstorming ideas for an essay, reflecting on something you've read or a recent activity;

Writing classes will usually be dynamic and interactive; you will get to know your peers and your instructors.
